

This colorful image was made in 2013 by a High Resolution Multi-beam Sonar Survey. It shows the wreck of the CSS *Georgia* shipwreck at the bottom of the Savannah River. Note how the wreck is spread across the river bottom. What remains of the vessel's casemate are the somewhat square and rectangular yellow and orange areas above. The dotted white line marks post-2003 damage to the wreck site. The Multi-beam Survey compliments the Side Scan Sonar Survey data. (Dean et al. Panamerican Consultants, Inc. 2013)
